On behalf of the Management of the SAVF Ons Hulde Old Age home, we would like to thank you for the donations and also for your time that you took to come and share the word of God with us.

SAVF Ons Hulde falls under the South African Women's Federation (SAVF) and is registered as a non-profit organisation.

In 1994, the Management realized the need within the previously disadvantaged community for the services provided by SAVF Ons Hulde, and the home started admitting these frail and homeless aged and disabled. Of the 80 residents in SAVF Ons Hulde, only 20 have the means to contribute to the full payment of their unit cost (R6720.00), resulting in a monthly shortfall of R2 800.00 per resident. The home has 33 residents who can't contribute in full.

It is therefore clear that SAVF Ons Hulde is rendering a service to the poorest of the poor and although the community has an open hand for SAVF Ons Hulde, it is not sufficient to cover all the expenses.

The SAVF Ons Hulde regards transformation as a priority and will therefore keep striving to provide services to all.

The loving staff and management of Self-Directed Learning Research Focus Area, NWU shared their wealth by giving to our needy residents. The platters received provided warmth and sense of belonging to our residents.
