

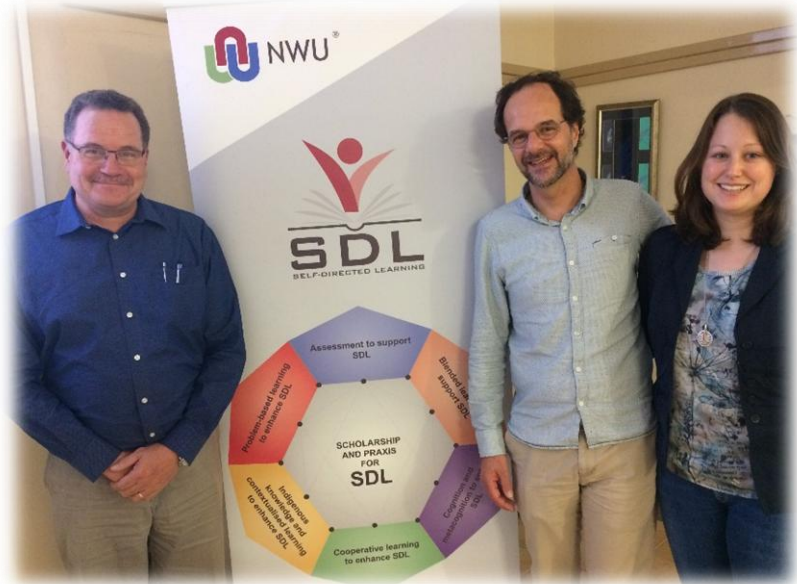
The latest SDL news...

A privilege indeed!



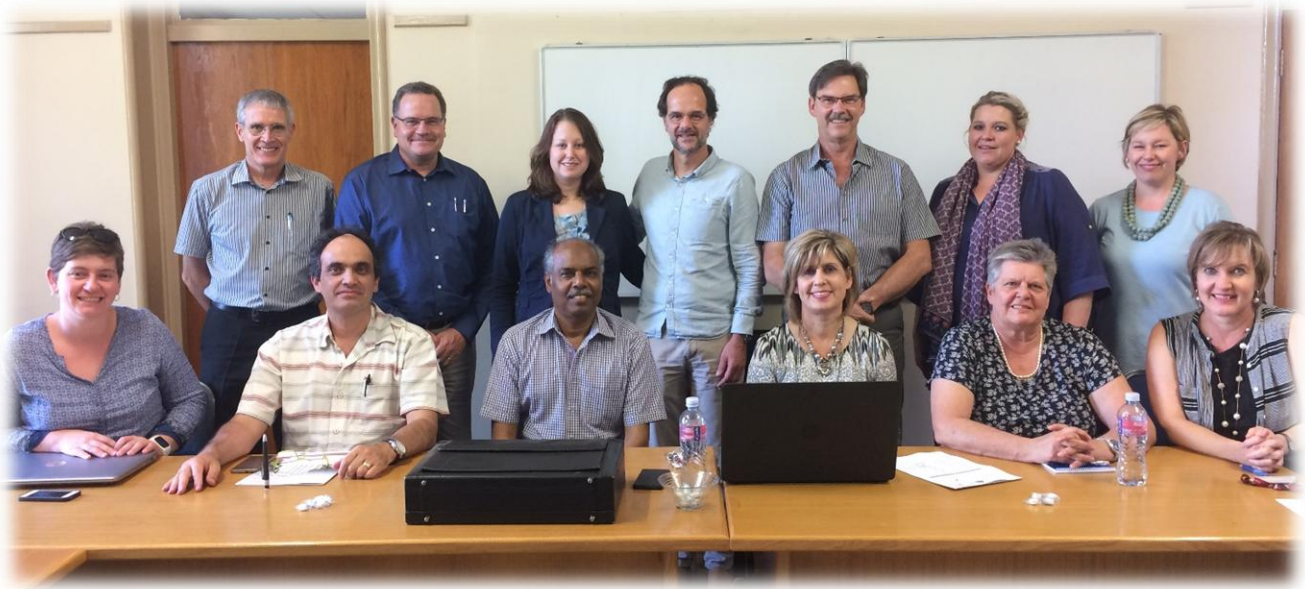
