ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- APS: Minimum of 26
- A National Senior Certificate with endorsement for bachelor's studies and with appropriate subject combinations and performance levels as per Government Gazette 31231 (2008).
- Language of instruction: Home Language and First Additional Language level 4 (50-59%). To register First Additional Language as Language of Learning and Teaching, a level 5 (60-69%) is required for the First Additional Language.
- Languages available to choose from as a Language of Learning and Teaching (LoLT) are Afrikaans, English, isiXhosa, Sesotho, or Setswana. Languages available to choose from as a Language of Conversational Competence (LoCC) are Afrikaans, isiXhosa, Sesotho, and Setswana. Please note that the LoLT and the LoCC may not be the same language.
- Clearance certificate in terms of the provisions of the Children's Act, Act 38 of 2005, as persons suitable to work with babies, toddlers and young children as contemplated in section 97(3) and duly verified against Part B of the National Protection Register in accordance with section 126 of the said Act.
- Access to a computer and sufficient Wi-Fi.

TOELATINGSVEREISTES:

- APS: Minimum van 26
- 'n Nasionale Senior Sertikaat met endossement vir baccalaureus-studies en met toepaslike vakkombinasies en prestasievlekke volgens Staatskoerant 31231 (2008).
- Onderrigtaal: Huistaal en Eerste Addisionele Taal-vlak 4 (50-59%). Om Eerste Addisionele Taal as Taal van Onderrig en Leer te registreer, word 'n vlak 5 (60-69%) vir die Eerste Addisionele Taal vereis.
Tale wat beskikbaar is om van te kies as 'n Taal van Onderrig en Leer (TvOL) is Afrikaans, Engels, isiXhosa, Sesotho, of Setswana. Tale beskikbaar om van te kies as 'n Taal van Gespreksbevoegdheid (TvGB) is Afrikaans, isiXhosa, Sesotho, en Setswana. Let daarop dat die TvOL en die TvGB nie dieselfde taal mag wees nie.
- Uitklaringssertikaat ingevolge die bepalings van die Kinderwet, Wet 38 van 2005, as persone wat geskik is om met babas, kleuters en klein kindertjies te werk soos bedoel in artikel 97(3) en behoorlik geverifieer teen Deel B van die Nasionale Beskermingsregister ingevolge artikel 126 van genoemde Wet.
- Toegang tot 'n rekenaar en voldoende Wi-Fi.
