Minimum requirements

- A relevant undergraduate qualification with 2 high school subjects (a recognised school subject that can be offered at school) of which you will be learning the methodology during your PGCE studies.
- Applications subject to a selection process and capacity.

Method of delivery: Full Time

- Oualification code: 4DCG02
- Obtain your PGCE qualification within 1 year if you register as a full-time student.
- Class attendance is from Monday Friday on campus.
- Not all methodologies are offered on all campuses.
- All students must be available for 2 series of 4 consecutive weeks teaching practice in 1 year at a secondary school.

Minimum requirements

- A relevant undergraduate qualification with 2 high school subjects (a recognised school subject that can be offered at school) of which you will be learning the methodology during your PGCE studies.
- Applications are subject to a selection process and capacity.

Method of delivery: Distance

- Oualification code: 4DDG02
- Students who are unable to enroll for the PGCE at one of the NWU campuses for the contact programme, may apply for the PGCE through the Unit of Distance learning. The programme is offered in a minimum of 1 year and maximum of 3 years. The programme is only offered distance in SA and Namibia.
- Examinations for students in die distance programme are written at NWU examination centres in SA and Namibia.
- Modern communication technologies are used for contact between staff students.

- All students must be available for 2series of 4 consecutive weeks teaching practice in 1 year at a secondary school.
- Language of instruction are only available in English.
