## Help with specific subjects:

When you need advice on a specific subject, for example the content, how it will be lectured and how it will be assessed, you need to **contact your lecturer**. All lecturers can be contacted on their GroupWise email: [staff-number@nwu.ac.za](mailto:staff-number@nwu.ac.za)

You can also look them up on the faculty website at <https://education.nwu.ac.za/> by selecting the field of study, e.g. "Language Education" for a language module, then clicking on "Staff" tab and selecting the specific language, e.g. "African Languages".
