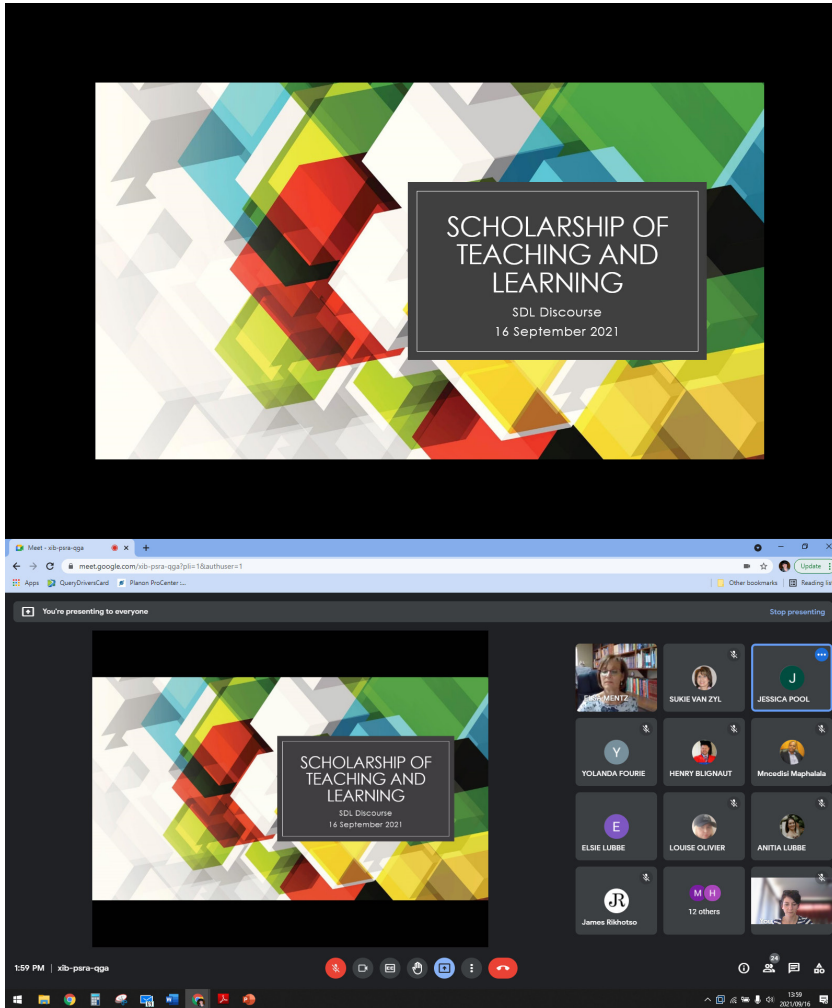


SDL discourse



On 16 September 2021, the Research Unit for Self-Directed Learning (RU SDL) hosted another successful discourse. The topic of this discourse was Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL). During the discourse, participants had the opportunity to engage with Dr Jessica Pool (member of the RU SDL and SoTL project manager for CTL) and especially clarify questions and aspects that were perhaps still unfamiliar to some. Five members of the RU SDL (Dr Sukie van Zyl, Dr Tertia Jordaan, Mr Sfiso Mahlaba, Dr Chantelle Bosch and Dr Dorothy Laubscher) also shared their experiences regarding SoTL research, and in particular addressed the following four themes:

- Getting students on board;
- Getting colleagues on board;
- Managing the workload; and
- Utilising resources.

The discourse stimulated great questions and conversations regarding SoTL research and the funding opportunities that are available to researchers. Furthermore, participants

could engage in lively discussions about the feasibility of SoTL research and how to overcome challenges that may arise.

Die diskoers het goeie vrae en gesprekke rakende VvOL-navorsing asook befondsingsgeleenthede vir navorsers uitgelok. Verder kon deelnemers aan lewendige gesprekke rakende die vatbaarheid van VvOL-navorsing deelneem, en oor hoe om die uitdagings wat kan opduik, te oorkom.
