SDL hosts webinar presented by Prof Jako Olivier and international collaborators

On 29 June 2021, the research unit SDL presented a webinar on editing and writing book chapters. The presenters were experienced book editors: Prof Daniel Burgos (extraordinary professor of the research unit SDL and vice-rector for International Research, UNESCO Chair on eLearning and ICDE Chair in OER at Universidad Internacional de La Rioja, Spain) together with Dr Ahmed Tlili (co-director of the OER lab at the Smart Learning Institute of Beijing Normal University in China), and Prof Jako Olivier (UNESCO Chair on Multimodal Learning and OER), who also facilitated the discussion. The webinar addressed questions regarding the basic steps when editing a book, selecting an appropriate publisher, and writing book proposals for publishers. The main differences between journal articles and book chapters were highlighted, and the presenters shared best practices and their experiences as editors. There was ample time for questions and the 30 researchers who joined the webinar greatly benefited from the expertise of the three presenters.



SGL-webinaar deur Prof Jako Olivier en internasionale kollegas aangebied

Die navorsingseenheid vir SGL het op 29 Junie 2021 'n webinaar oor die redigering en skryf van hoofstukke in boeke aangebied. Die aanbieders was ervare boekredakteurs: Prof Daniel Burgos (buitengewone professor van die navorsingseenheid SGL en viserektor vir Internasionale Navorsing, UNESCO-leerstoel oor e-Leer en ICDE-leerstoel in OOH aan Universidad Internacional de La Rioja, Spanje), asook dr Ahmed Tlili (mededirekteur van die OOH-laboratorium aan die Smart Learning Institute van die Beijing Normal University in Sjina), en prof Jako Olivier (UNESCO-leerstoel vir multimodale leer en OOH), wat ook die bespreking gelei het.

Die webinaar het vrae rakende die basiese stappe van die redigering van 'n boek, die kies van gepaste uitgewers, en die skryf van boekvoorstelle vir uitgewers bespreek. Die belangrikste verskille tussen tydskrifartikels en boekhoofstukke is uitgelig, en die aanbieders het beste praktyke en hulle ervarings as redakteurs gedeel. Daar was genoeg tyd vir vrae en die 30 navorsers wat die webinaar bygewoon het, kon groot voordeel uit die kundigheid van die drie aanbieders trek.

Appointment of the Deputy Dean: Teaching and Learning



Prof Maryna Reyneke has been appointed as deputy dean for Teaching and Learning in the Faculty of Education for a three-year term with effect from 1 August 2021.

Prof Reyneke is an associate professor and former director of the School for Language Education and the BEd programme in the Faculty of Education. She has vast experience in teaching and learning, with a background in education that spans 35 years. After working in secondary education for nearly two decades, Prof Reyneke joined the NWU in 2003 as a lecturer in English for Education with an MA in Applied Linguistics. Shortly thereafter she obtained a PhD in Teaching and Learning, focusing on assessment in English language teaching. She has been the proud receiver of two ITEAs from the NWU, one as a distinguished lecturer. She was also nominated for the Rapport Top Lecturer award in 2012.

Prof Reyneke will continue to build on the solid foundation laid by her predecessor, Prof Herman van Vuuren, who held the position of deputy dean for Teaching and Learning in the faculty for the last three years. Prof Van Vuuren successfully led the integration of teaching and learning across the three campuses with distinction. He also spearheaded the remote teaching process, with the many challenges presented by Covid-19, and is commended for his dedication and hard work.

Prof Maryna Reyneke is met ingang van 1 Augustus 2021 vir 'n driejaartermyne as adjunkdekaan vir Onderrig en Leer in die Fakulteit Opvoedkunde aangestel.

Prof Reyneke is 'n medeprofessor en voormalige direkteur van die Skool vir Taalonderwys en die BEd-program in die Fakulteit Opvoedkunde. Sy het uitgebreide ervaring in onderrig en leer, met 'n agtergrond in die onderwys wat 35 jaar omspan. Nadat sy vir amper twee dekades in sekondêre onderwys gewerk het, het prof Reyneke in 2003 met 'n MA-graad in Toegepaste Taalkunde as dosent in Engels vir Onderwys by die NWU aangesluit. Sy het kort daarna 'n PhD in Onderrig en Leer verwerf en op assessering in Engels-taalonderrig gefokus. Sy is die trotse ontvanger van twee ITOU'e van die NWU, een as voortreflike dosent. Sy is ook in 2012 vir Rapport se toekenning as topdosent benoem.

Prof Reyneke sal voortgaan om op die vaste fondament te bou wat gelê is deur haar voorganger, prof Herman van Vuuren, wat vir die afgelope drie jaar die pos as adjunkdekaan vir Onderrig en Leer in die fakulteite gehad het. Prof Van Vuuren het die integrasie van onderrig en leer regoor die drie kampusse met onderskeidings gelei. Hy was ook aan die voorpunt van die afstandsonderrigproses, met die vele uitdagings wat Covid-19 gebring het, en word vir sy toewyding en harde werk geloof.
