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Title: Transforming experiences of integrating Technology in Art Education: COVID-19 Pandemic Era

One of realities of today's world during the COVID-19 pandemic is that things are no longer the way they were. As the world was observing social distancing and the doors of schools were closed it became impossible for classroom settings to remain the same.
