**Title:** Leadership in arts and cultural education: African perspectives in the global context

A recent global study has generated a leadership framework for the arts and cultural education sector to help guide, disrupt, and re-imagine the possibilities for developing leaders in and through arts learning. The research was conducted through focus groups on all six continents and will locate the African perspective within the global context. The framework is grounded in arts entrepreneurship and educational futures, and will provide a meaningful tool for teachers, artists, organizational leaders, and other stakeholders in the arts and cultural education ecosystem to broaden and diversify the leadership pipeline. This focused webinar will share the research findings, facilitate discussion and personal and professional application of the framework and envision possibilities for the future of arts and cultural education in Sub-Saharan Africa.
